The American Lowline Junior Association will award a scholarship annually to a member of the American Lowline Junior Association. The winner will be announced during the National Western Stock Show Annual Banquet.

### **Eligibility:**

The applicant must be a member in good standing of the American Lowline Junior Association (ALJA); and have been a member of the ALJA for at least one full year. Scholarship funds are to be used for furthering the recipient's education in the field of their choice. Applicants must be at least a high school senior, as funds are for post-secondary education.

### **Funds:**

\$5,000 a year will be distributed to the scholarship candidates by the discretion of the scholarship committee. Juniors may reapply after receiving a scholarship.

### **Selection:**

The scholarship committee will evaluate all applicants and make their decision based on the merits of the application. Selection will be based on: academic record, activities and Lowline cattle involvement.
