We are entering a new and challenging era of the cattle business and no breed can contribute to lowering costs of high-quality beef production like American Aberdeens! We are excited to introduce a whole new concept for the 2021 National American Aberdeen Sale and new location in Grand Island, Nebraska.

This year, American Aberdeens will be on display and exhibited with several other breeds at The Nebraskan Livestock Show. The Nebraskan was started to fill the void left by the cancellation of the National Western Stock Show and is being held in the nearly new, outstanding facilities of the Fonner Park Complex and the Nebraska State Fairgrounds in the heart of cow country, Grand Island, Nebraska.

The sale will be Monday, January 11 at 4:00 PM and will be held after the open female show. This will enable us to solicit animals that placed well in the female show to be added to the sale. We hope this will increase our show spectators and their enthusiasm. If someone is interested in purchasing a show animal, they can approach the sale manager about getting that animal added to the sale. The show judge's placing will be used to make the sale order.

This will be the "Top Twenty Five" Sale – only entries of top-flight breeding stock will be accepted. Sale cattle must be entered in the National Show and **must show**.

We will not mail a sale catalog. An online sale catalog will be posted to the AAA and Auction Effertz websites following the entry deadline and will be updated regularly. This will allow for the dissemination of accurate, timely sale information and will substantially reduce sale expense. Consignors are encouraged to advertise their entries in the Ledger.

1. There will be a non-refundable \$200 per lot entry fee payable at the time of entry.
2. Sale expense for the National Sale will be 10% which will include facility charges, sale advertising, ring service, webcast, sale management, auctioneer, sale vet and 1% for the American Aberdeen Association. Transfer fees will be charged to the consignors.
3. No embryo or semen lots will be accepted.
4. Professional quality photos of sale cattle are required, high quality video is recommended. Consignor ads featuring such photos are also highly recommended in the winter issue of The Ledger.
5. All sale cattle must be entered in the National American Aberdeen Show. The deadline for show entries is December 5, 2020. If you have trouble finding an entry form, call Jan at 701-223-5202.
6. You must comply with The Nebraskan health and brand regulations. They are available at www.thenebraskan.org.
7. All females entered in the National Sale should be officially calfhooed vaccinated for brucellosis.
8. All breeding age bulls entered in the National Sale must be fertility tested and a copy of the fertility test must accompany the bull to the sale.
9. All sale entries must have the original AAA registration paper available prior to the sale or the animal will not be allowed to sell and entry fees will be forfeited. This includes any calves selling at the side of their dams.
10. All percentage cattle consigned to the National Sale must be DNA parent verified to at least one Aberdeen parent. This test must be completed prior to the sale and results sent to Auction Effertz,



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Ltd. In the case of percentage cattle added to the sale from the show, a DNA sample will be obtained before the show and submitted for parentage verification.

12. Sale cattle will be screened for quality, presentation and temperament. We will make every attempt to do this screening at the nomination stage.
