The American Aberdeen Association will collect seventy five (\$75.00) dollars per each entry fee including pens. Late entry fee an additional \$15.

1. All animals must have a legible tattoo and will be inspected at the show. Original registration certificates must accompany all animals at time of check-in. Any animal upon check-in that does not have a legible tattoo corresponding to its registration certificate is ineligible to show.

Each Pen will consist of three (3) bulls/heifers. Exhibitors must designate alternate bulls at check-in to the Aberdeen Pen Show Superintendent. There will be a Fullblood division and a Percentage/Purebred (50.0% - 99.9%) division. Bulls and heifers entered in the Pen division are eligible to show in the individual classes, and vice versa. They must pay an additional entry fee for the open show.

2. All animals entered in the National Aberdeen Show must be registered with the **American Aberdeen Association**. Exhibitors must have proof of registration at the time of check in at National Western Stock Show. There will be a Fullblood show and a Percentage/Purebred (1/2, 3/4, 7/8, etc.) show. Group classes can contain both Percentage or Purebred and Fullblood cattle in the same group and will all compete against each other.

3. Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of the show entry deadline. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual classes.

4. All animals must be properly tattooed and will be inspected at the show. Tattoo must be legible and must match registration papers.

5. All cattle must meet the health requirements set out by the Show Management. Any deviation will be just cause for immediate disqualification from the show.

6. All bulls born before September 1, 2019 must show with a noselead. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show committee.

7. Any female with a calf at side, regardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class. All females born before August 31, 2018 must be shown with calf at side.

8. Cow-Calf classes – Any female with a calf at side, regardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class. Calf must be cow's natural calf. Cows that are exhibited with calves at the side must be lactating to calves

born on or after May 1, 2020 and must be nursing. Calf entries in the Cow-Calf class may be shown individually providing individual entry has been made. Cows may be evaluated and screened out of the show on the basis of udder quality. The determination of the show committee will be final.

9. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation, or not abiding by the show rules, will be disqualified and denied the privilege of showing.

10. The individual classes will be made up and divided after the cattle are checked in at the show. Any of the classes may be split if classes become too large, at the discretion of show management. They will be judged from the youngest class to the oldest class.

11. Any animal entered in the Pen Division is eligible to show in the individual classes, and vice versa. They will be required to pay an entry fee for the open show.

### **JUNIOR BREEDING HEIFER DIVISION**

**ENTRY FEE:** No entry fee if entered in Open Show – If not entered in Open show \$75 entry fee. Late

Entry fee add an additional \$15.

**1.** To be eligible to exhibit in this division, exhibitors must be enrolled and a member in good standing in the American Aberdeen Junior and not more than twenty one (21) years as of January 1, 2021.

**2.** All heifers must meet criteria as listed in the open show.

**3.** All heifers must be the property of and in the possession of the Participant as of November 20, 2020. Ownership must be shown by breed registry transfer date. Registration must be in the name of Participant as of December 1st.

**4.** Classes may be divided or combined at the discretion of Management.

**5.** Substitutions within the same class and same owner only will be accepted. There will be no substitution of animals in different classes. Only one (1) substitution for original animal will be allowed. Substitutions must be in writing.

Classes shall be split as near to equal numbers as possible by show superintendents.
