

MULTIPLE Sire GROUP – Application Form

The use of two or more registered Aberdeen bulls in the pasture with a group of cows is permitted under the following conditions:

- 1) The multiple sire registration process was approved to register (first cross) halfblood and lower percentage calves sired by a registered multiple sire group comprised of registered and DNA parentage verified Lowline bulls.
- 2) It is recommended that the bulls be of like percentage Aberdeen blood. Such as, all Fullblood bulls or all 3/4 bloods or all half-bloods.
- 3) In cases where percentage bulls are used with Fullblood bulls the resulting calves would be eligible to be registered at the lowest common percentage. For example, when half-blood bulls are register in a multiple sire group with Fullblood bulls the resulting calves could only be registered as quarter-bloods.
