

American Aberdeen board of directors meeting.

Feb.8th 6:30 P.M. CST

Dr. Walker called meeting to order at 6:32 CST via teleconference call.

Members present: Rob Fanning, Allen Sieverkropp, Jack Sandford, Rebecca Miller, Darwin Engelkes, and Rick Dodd.

Rob Fanning brought forward recommendations from the show and sale committee to pertain to all American Aberdeen Shows.

Remove the requirement to have a semen test on bulls.

Remove dates from shows for senior yearlings and have a straight requirement that any female 20 months of age at the time of the specific show be confirmed pregnant.

Moved by Darwin, seconded by Rob to approve the show and sale committee recommendations.

Rob explained the frustrations with the semen test on bulls and having a specific date for each show with the pregnancy requirement. This will streamline the requirements in each show program.

Motion carried.

Rob also brought forward information from the Cattlemen's Congress Show in OK. We would have to have a minimum 50 head at the show or we as an association would have to kick in the difference in premium money. This year we had 18 entered, so the amount would be significant that we would have to provide. Motion made by Darwin, seconded by Allen to not attend or promote the Cattlemen's Congress show in 2023.
